speeches they had written. They also sang beautifully. Thank you to parents who were

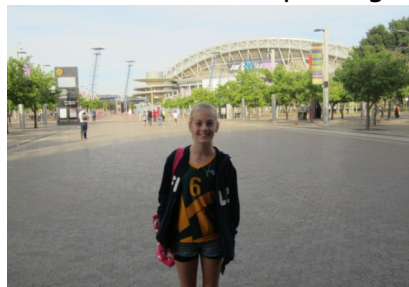

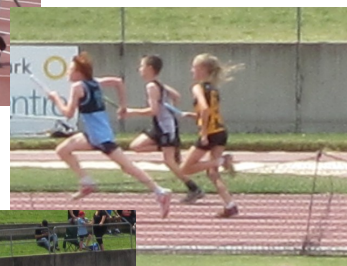
