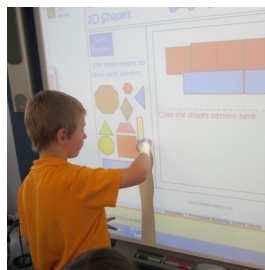
Market Day at The Risk

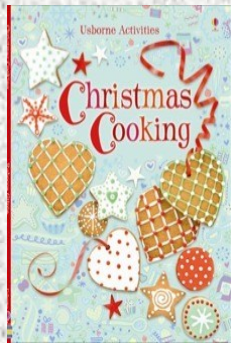
