### Cricket Challenge

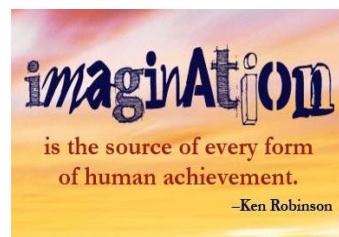
