Indigenous Book Swap

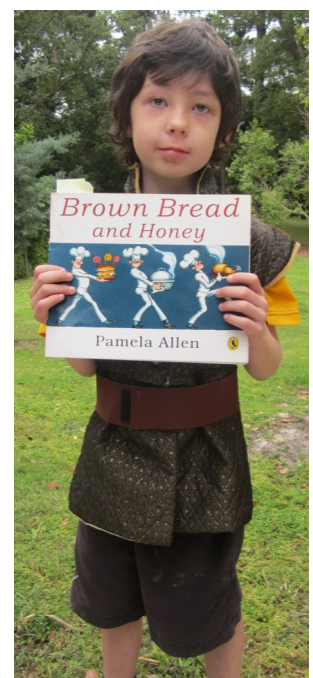
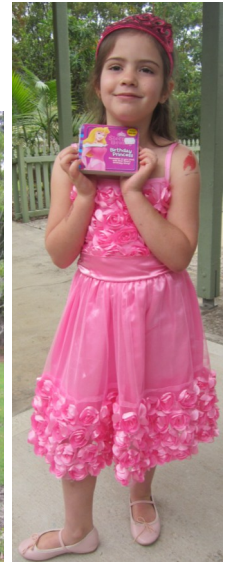
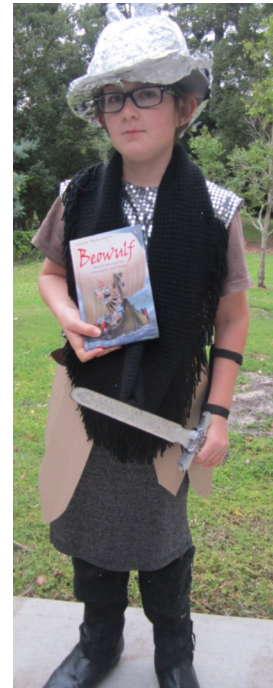
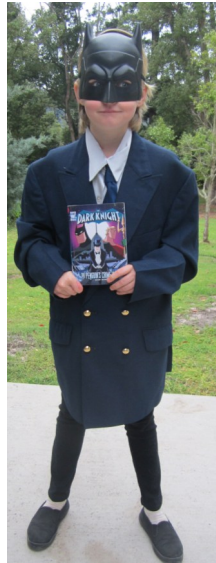
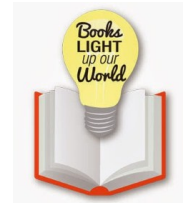
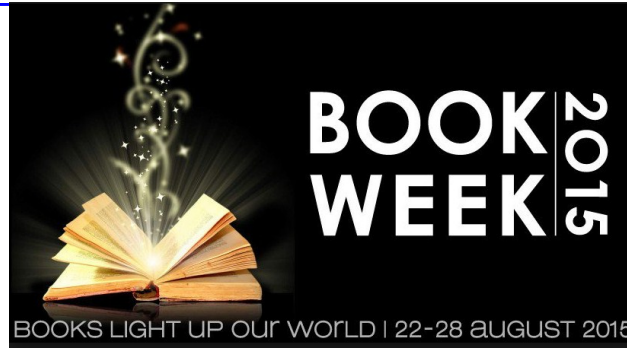
